ABSTRACT

With the advent of digital photography, the disappearance of commercial photography labs and improvements in printing and computer technologies more and more photographers are turning to their home computers to provide negatives for their alternative process printing needs. This session will demonstrate one method for creating digital negatives from computer files using Adobe® Photoshop® for alternative process printing.
