John Baldessari American, 2000 Specimen (After Dürer) Ink-jet on canvas with UV coating, mounted on fiberglass composite panel with stainless-steel T-pin 2000.37 John Baldessari's *Specimen (After Dürer)* is a work of art that copies another and then adds something new to make an interesting combination. By enlarging the copied art (a stag beetle drawn by Albrecht Dürer) and adding the giant pin, Baldessari changes the way we see the beetle.

Think of a song or saying you already know, then write it down on a carton, cup, rock, or other object. How does that change it? How might writing it small or big change it? You can also add new words to make new meanings.
