Promised

- Francesca/Patricia: post workshop PowerPoints to Vocabulary Program Web pages
- DIBAM: contact Chilean conservation project
- DIBAM: contact Museo de Bellas Artes and Museo Precolumbino re: sending sample CONA records
- Joan: download MACE taxonomies, share with Patricia, see if they can be loaded into AAT
- Gregg: Give State Museums of Berlin a list of the AAT records that already have German terms
- State Museums of Berlin : Send a small sample of CONA contributions; Vocabulary Program will flesh out with links to other vocabularies by December 15

Promised *continued*

- RKD: Send information about accessing ICONCLASS via Web services; examples of how RKD is using SKOS; investigate artist names for ULAN; contact Rijksmuseum re: sample contributions to CONA
- Gregg and Patricia: analyze RKD artist data and respond to RKD
- Francesca: investigate Weebly (or Blackboard) etc. for creating an ITWG forum
- Te Papa: send 160 museum records to analyze for CONA
- Gregg: make requested modifications to Web services
- Massimiliano and Lina: complete articles for Getty Research Journal: **by Christmas**

- DIBAM: send plural forms of remaining AAT descriptors

Promised *cont.*

- Joan, Gregg, Patricia: make available the controlled lists for validation of certain data elements
- Te Papa, RKD, TELDAP: think about proposing papers for upcoming issue(s) of Getty Research Journal
- Maureen (with Murtha): look at current agreements and get back to group by January 2012
- Joan: talk to Gallery Systems (TMS) about using Web services, updating data; CONA export from TMS (e.g. in LIDO XML format)

- RKD: send new data to Gregg; work with Gregg to develop a process and rules for updating contributed data
- Joan and Patricia: advertise maintenance schedule for online data
