# Procedures (for example 2)

(1) Obtain the "Silk Road" **ID** from TGN;

(2) Using the ID to request through Getty Vocabularies Web
 Services APIs\* to get data of locations related to the "Silk Road";
 obtain the datasets in XML format;

(3) Extract *preferred name, non-prefer name, type of place,* and *Coordinates* from **XML file**; store data in the **PostgreSQL** spatial database;

(4) Present data on and interact with the defined geographical area on the map using **Google Map API**.

\*The data files may be accessed through Web services APIs (application programming interfaces), which provide access to data that is refreshed every two weeks. Note that the data is subject to frequent additions and updates.
