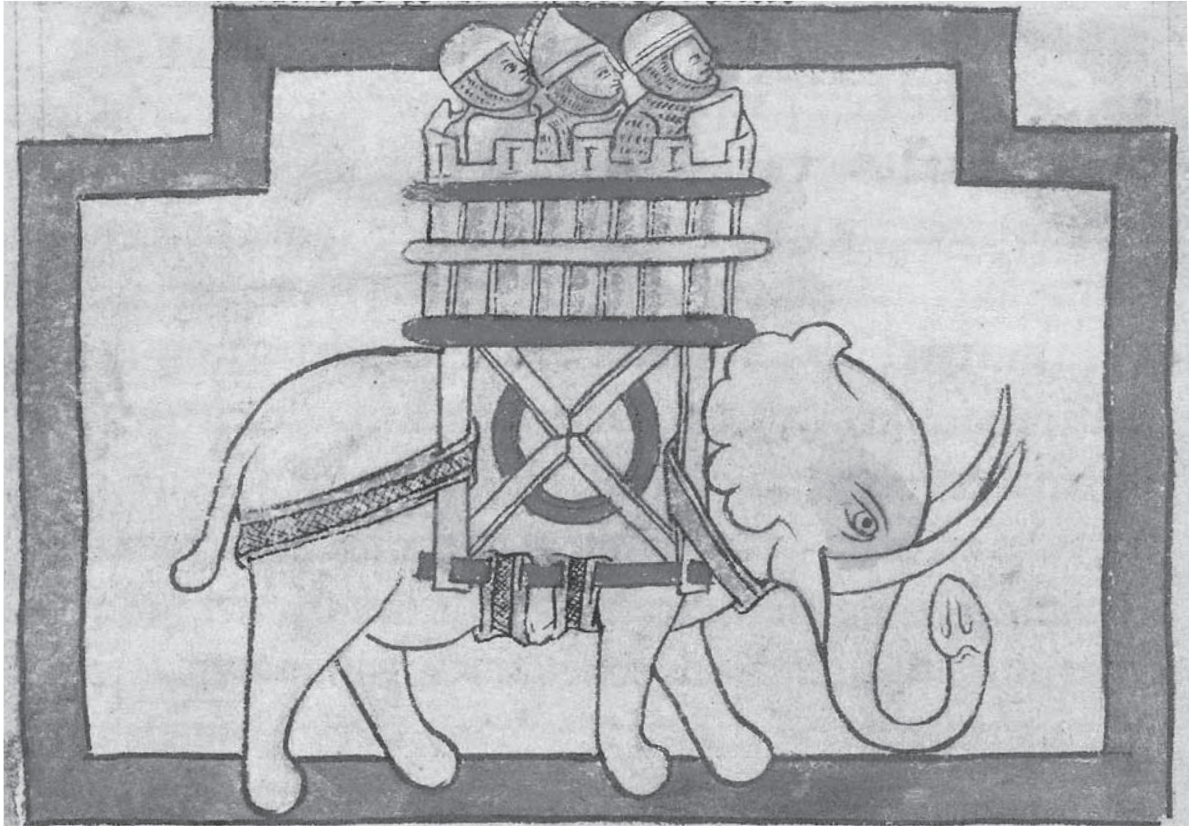


## Introducing Shape

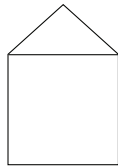

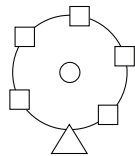
Build a vocabulary of shapes. Use the table below to experiment with drawing different types of shapes.

Triangle	Square	Rectangle	Circle	Oval	

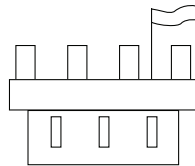
For a quick drawing exercise, use shapes to create simple forms. Below are some examples.



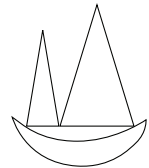
