Update of the digitization project at the IMJ

- 350,000 museum objects registered in database for the three wings: Art, Judaica and Archeology
- 150,000 study collection and archival item
- At least one image for each item
- Over 100,000 bilingual lexicon terms in 10 main tables:

Artists, Object name, Periods, Place, Materials, Technique, Keywords

Cultural customization

The lexicon is a living organism vital to a museum's complex database. For the initial stages of its creation museum's legacy terms were translated from Hebrew to English (and vice versa). These terms are specific to the museum's locality and culture. They include foreign language terms like "Lulwi" (Yemenite Festive Dress) and names of local artists like "Tumarkin, Igael".

The Bilingual Lexicon

Synonyms

This important tool allows the computer to recognize words and its variations or synonyms. An example is that "Lvov" and "Lemberg" refer to the same place at different points in time. A person can search Lvov and find information about objects associated with the city Lemberg.

Translation

Another important job accomplished by the lexicon is the ability to help translate often used terms. This solves another problem, The Israel Museum, Jerusalem is a bilingual institution and the database will allow us to circumvent translation of lexicon words.

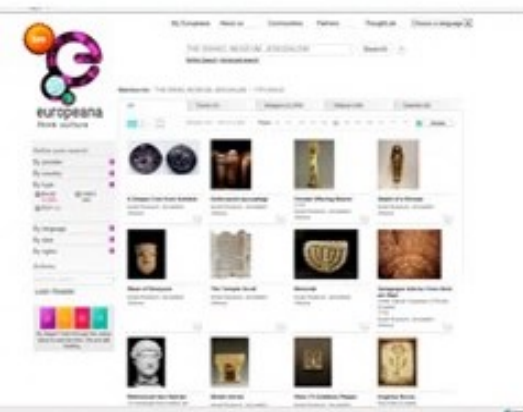

Classification is no easy issue in any field: epigraphy is no exception to this rule. Traditionally the CIL VI (Rome) classification has been used as a reference, as this typology has served as a model for all epigraphic production in the Roman Empire. There are nevertheless new glossaries and classification curated by CIL, which retain the limits of a formal classification, together with the benefits of this.

A digital vocabulary in a structured data format allows to be flexible, align data and harmonize content without forcing one or the other project or publication to change its mind about the structure used.

Pablo Picasso (/piˈkɑːsoʊ, -ˈkæsoʊ/^[a]; Spanish: [ˈpaβlo piˈkaso]; 25 October 1881 – 8 April 1973) was a Spanish painter, sculptor, printmaker, ceramicist, stage designer, poet and playwright who spent most of his adult life in France. Regarded as one of the most influential artists of the 20th century, he is known for co-founding the **Cubist** movement, the invention of constructed sculpture,^[b]^[c] the co-invention of collage, and for the wide variety of styles that he helped develop and explore. Among his most famous works are the proto-Cubist *Les Femmes d'Alger* (O.J. No. 116) (1907), and *Guernica* (1937), a dramatic portrayal of the bombing of Guernica by the German and Italian airforces.

Picasso demonstrated extraordinary artistic talent in his early years, painting in a naturalistic manner through his childhood and adolescence. During the first decade of the 20th century, his style changed as he experimented with different theories, techniques, and ideas. After 1906, the Fauvist work of the slightly older artist Henri Matisse motivated Picasso to explore more radical styles, beginning a fruitful rivalry between the two artists, who subsequently were often paired by critics as the leaders of modern art.^[d]^[e]

Picasso's work is often categorized into periods. While the names of many of his later periods are debated, the most commonly accepted periods in his work are the **Blue Period** (1901–1904), the **Rose Period** (1904–1906), the **African-influenced Period** (1907–1909), **Analytic Cubism** (1909–1912), and **Synthetic Cubism** (1912–1919), also referred to as the **Crystal period**. Much of Picasso's work of the late 1910s and early 1920s is in a **neoclassical** style, and his work in the mid-1920s often has characteristics of **Surrealism**. His later work often combines elements of his earlier styles.


Exceptionally prolific throughout the course of his long life, Picasso achieved universal renown and immense fortune for his revolutionary artistic accomplishments, and became one of the best-known figures in 20th-century art.

Lola Beer Ebner (1916-1997) was an [Israeli fashion designer](#).

Lola Beer Ebner was born in [Czechoslovakia](#). She studied at the Prague College of Design.

In Israel, she became known as the "national dresser" for designing the clothes of the wives of Israeli prime ministers and politicians. In the 1950s, she designed uniforms for [Ei Al](#) stewardesses and in the 1960s, the uniforms for [Israel Defense Force](#) women soldiers. She designed the academic robes of the [Weizmann Institute](#) and theater costumes. She also designed a ready-made line for [ATA](#) and marketed two perfumes, "Dimona" and "Dimont."^[1] Beer Ebner took her inspiration from Paris and quipped that it would "at least five hundred years" to develop uniquely Israeli fashion.^[2]

An exhibit of Beer Ebner's work was held in 2010 at Tel Aviv's Czech Center.^[3]

Lola Beer (Ebner) immigrated to the Land of Israel in 1940. She was a pioneer of high fashion - haute couture - in Israel. She designed clothes for the wives of Israeli prime ministers, presidents and diplomats. Beer designed the uniforms for Israel's women soldiers and El Al airline stewardesses, academic robes for the Weizmann Institute and theater costumes. In the 1960s, she also designed fashionable dresses in bright colors for Israel's ATA textile factory, which had produced mainly uniforms and work clothing from the 1930s. Died March, 1997.
