
This instruction sheet will help you guide your students at the Getty Villa as they work on the Student Worksheet on the following pages.

GOALS> TIPS>


- To identify the unique attributes of a chosen god or goddess from ancient Greek or Roman mythology

To complete the "Ancient Greek and Roman Talk Show" visit activity, groups will find a garden sculpture in the Outer Peristyle Garden.








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
