
Sending first set of Portuguese descriptors

- 5084 terms (preferred terms, alternative terms and equivalent English terms)
- 2318 Portuguese descriptors with definitions sent for AAT
- 832 definitions summaries
- Support for improving the Artificial Intelligence tool for retrieving architectural images.
- Planning to contribute with the CONA, IA, TGN and ULAN.
- Becoming the CVAA-BR a terminological reference in Portuguese for descriptors of Art and Architecture.
